### **Position Description**

**Term:** Two years, but renewable without limit

**Estimated Time Commitment:** approximately 5 hours per month

#### **General Overview:**

According to the OHABA Bylaws, the Student Representative Committee serves to maintain positive relations with regional colleges and universities offering coursework in Applied Behavior Analysis to promote active student involvement through recognition of student submissions to the annual conference.

#### **Specific Responsibilities:**

1. Forms and presents a Student Representative Committee to the Board for approval.
2. Communicates the needs and concerns of new professionals or students.
3. Discusses issues related to students seeking national and local certification with the Board.
4. Writes and presents a summary of the Student Representative Committee's activities for the quarterly OHABA Board meetings.
5. Attends quarterly Board Member meetings.
6. Monitors and manages email sent to the Student Representative Committee no less than on a weekly basis.
